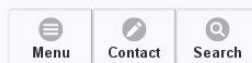
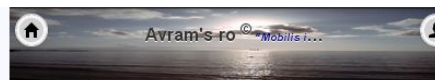

The website uses, in its different parts, the following technologies: HTML5, XML, CSS3, JavaScript, jQuery, jQuery mobile, Ajax, Json, PHP, MySQL. The CSS3 for jQuery mobile do not pass integrally the CSS3 W3 Validation checks by few added features which not a part of the standard. More than I found useful the usage
